



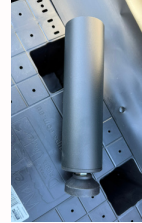

WICKING PLANTER BOX SETUP

Position the Garden Bed - Place your planted box on a level surface. The overflow outlet should sit slightly lower to allow proper drainage

If your Planter Box was supplied with a support leg, tip the planter box backwards and screw in the support leg.



Insert the Inlet Pipe to the Wicking - There are 3 grab points that will fit snugly into the wicking - make sure it is a firm fit.



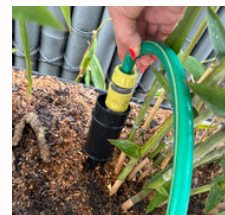
Fill the wicking cells with Perlite - Fill the square sections in the black wicking cells with perlite, filling each section right to the top.



Add Soil - Fill the planted box with a good quality soil mix until the soil level sits just below the top of the inlet pipe.

Plant and Mulch - Add your plants to the garden bed. Spread a good quality mulch around the plants and over the soil surface to help prevent the soil from drying out.

Fill the Wicking Reservoir - Remove the cap from the inlet pipe and fill with water through the inlet pipe. Fill until you see water coming out of the overflow pipe, then stop filling.



Water your Plants - Lightly water from the top. For the first 1–2 weeks, lightly water from the top every second day to help plants establish strong roots.



Check the Water Level - Check the water level in the reservoir once a week to see if it needs topping up. You can either, install a water level indicator (pictured), or place a timber rod into the inlet pipe (like a car oil dipstick) to check the water level.



Monthly Maintenance - Once a month, wipe the Eco board sides and Colorbond panels of your planted box with a damp cloth to remove dust or dirt.
